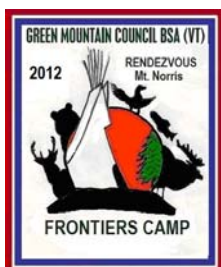

The Frontiers Camp program includes four different programs based on the year of attendance. Programs include merit badges, Vermont Hunter Safety (Rifle, Bow, and Trapper) programs and Let's Go Fishing, BSA rank advancement, frontiersman camp projects, history and stories, historically accurate rendezvous contests of physical skill such as log rolling, wrestling and tomahawk throwing, numerous craft projects, active games, fun campfires, great meals, and much more.
