Camp Fee

Please register for Frontiers Camp by sending the form below to the Council Service Center along with a non-refundable registration fee of \$75. Registration will reserve your place in this limited enrollment program.

Frontiers Camp "Early Bird" Camp Fee	\$245.00	Same as last year - <u>includes reservation fee</u>
Frontiers Camp "Regular" Camp Fee	\$280.00	Same as last year - <u>includes reservation fee</u>
Late Fee	\$20.00	This is an additional charge to the Early Bird or Regular camp fee IF the balance or total of your camp fee is received at the Council Service Center after June 4, 2012

Explanation of Camp Fees

- To qualify for the "early bird" (discounted) \$245.00 camp fee, you must have fully paid your camp fee to the Council Service Center by May 15, 2012. (Remember to subtract the reservation fee when sending in a balance.)
- If you have not fully paid your camp fee by May 15, 2012, the total "regular" camp fee of \$280 becomes applicable. Getting your balance in by May 15 will save you about 14% over the regular Frontiers Camp fee. (Remember to subtract the reservation fee when sending in a balance.)
- The entire camp fee is due to the Council Service Center by June 4, 2012. If your camp fee or balance is received after that date, your Frontiers Camp fee becomes \$300 (which includes a \$20 late fee.) Paying before June 6 saves you over 7% when compared to the regular Frontiers Camp fee and about 20% when the \$300 fee is compared to the Frontiers Camp early bird fee.
- Please note: you may pay your camp fees using a credit/debit card and calling the council service center. However, you will be charged the credit /debit card use fee of 3% also.

Camperships

If you are applying for a campership, you must submit a Frontiers Camp reservation form and the reservation fee of \$75.00 as well. Approximately one-half of the total "early bird discounted" camp fee (or \$125.00) must be paid into the Council Service Center by May 15, 2012.

If this \$125 is not paid by May 15, 2012, your total Frontiers Camp fee balance due will be the balance of the total "regular" fee of \$280 less the campership award and the initial registration deposit of \$125.

Once camperships are awarded, the balance of the discounted Frontiers Camp fee is due within two weeks. Otherwise, your total Frontiers Camp fee balance due will be the balance of the total "regular" fee of \$280 less the campership award and the initial registration deposit of \$125 (and any other deposits). If you do not pay the balance before June 4, 2012, your total camp fee balance will be the total of the regular camp fee of \$280, plus the late fee of \$20 (total of \$300) less the registration fee, and any other deposits you have made.

Campership Forms are due April 15, 2012 at the Council Service Center, PO Box 557, Waterbury, VT 05676

Note: When you register for Frontiers Camp prior to March 15, 2012 you will receive a no-extra-cost Frontiers Camp T-shirt (which are distributed at camp)

Refunds in excess of the non-refundable reservation fee can be made on written notification addressed and received at the Council Service Center prior to June 4, 2012. After June 4 refunds cannot be made as the food and equipment will have been purchased.
