



## VERMONT SILVER BEAVER RECIPIENTS

The Silver Beaver award was introduced in 1931 as a means of recognizing Scouters who provide distinguished service to youth at the council level. The award is made by the National Council, upon the recommendation of the Local Council. From 1971 to 1974, the Boy Scouts of America awarded the Silver Fawn to female Scouters as an alternative to the Silver Beaver.
