POSITION DESCRIPTION

Position Title: AQUATICS DIRECTOR

Reports to: Program Director

REQUIREMENTS:

The aquatics director is a man or woman, 21 years of age or older, of well known character, who demonstrates an ability to work with others and instruct Cub Scouts and their Leaders in BB aquatic safety and skills. Must hold current BSA National Camp School certification for Aquatics Director, current CPR certification from the American Red Cross or American Heart Association, and current First Aid certification by the American Red Cross. Possess the ability to swim and make rescue attempts. Has the ability to see the entire aquatics area. Registered with the BSA.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Prepare a well-rounded aquatics program for resident cub camp. Enforce national aquatics policies in camp. Instruct all aspects of the aquatics area. This includes, row boating, canoeing, swimming, and instructional swim. Manage the aquatic staff.

SPECIFIC DUTIES:

- Check and maintain inventory of all aquatics equipment
- Prepare outlines and plans for aquatic training/safety and activities
- Maintain and enforce national safety standards
- Is responsible for safe and proper use of aquatic equipment
- Train aquatics staff
- Supervise aquatics area and staff
- File opening and closing inventory
- Prepare awards as determined by yourself and the Program Director
- As a member of the program staff, it is your responsibility to make your part of the program as interesting as possible so campers and their leaders will want to participate
- Keep the program in tune with the yearly theme
- Upholds the ideals of the Scout Oath and Law
- Other duties as assigned
