CAMPERSHIP APPLICATION

Limited funds are available for Camperships for Scouts *registered in Green Mountain Council* who could not otherwise afford to attend a Green Mountain Council summer camp. The Camperships are subject to the following conditions:

1. The Scout should pay as much as possible.
2. The unit or chartered organization should pay as much as possible.
3. The unit should provide money-earning opportunities for Scouts.
4. The Scout should participate in the council popcorn sale.
5. Unit Committees should apply only for the balance needed after the above sources are exhausted.
6. Scouts should be assigned some task to perform commensurate with the campership, so they have the feeling of earning their own way.
7. The maximum for a campership is 1/2 of the Early Bird fee.

Deadline for application is April 15, 2011

Scoutmasters/Cubmasters will be notified, if a campership has been approved and if so, the amount.
