Prerequisites

Lifeguarding

- 15 years of age. Parent and Leader approval
- Mature and Dependable character
- Swim continuously for 550 yards using the following strokes in good form: front crawl, breaststroke, elementary backstroke and sidestroke
- Starting in the water, swim 20 yards using the front crawl or breaststroke, surface dive 7-10 feet, retrieve a 10-pound object, return to the surface, swim 20 yards back to the starting point while holding the object and exit the water without using a ladder or steps, within 1 minute and 40 seconds
- Read book prior to camp. Complete Medical Form.

Scuba

- 15 years of age. Parent and Leader approval
- Mature and Dependable character
- Pass the BSA swimmers test
- Read book and complete knowledge review prior to attending camp. Completed Medical Form.

General Information

Who: Any registered scout in need of a new, challenging and exciting program who meets the prerequisites.

What: Upon completion of the course, successful participants will be either certified Life Guards or Open Water Divers along with first aid and CPR. Participants will have the ability to earn other BSA awards and at least partial completion of aquatic merit badges.

When: Sunday June 24th – Saturday June 30th
Check in 1pm on Sunday.
