The commitment by adult role models help build a straight road for youth to follow into the future. Scouting helps youth of Vermont find in themselves and in the world around them-more than they thought possible.



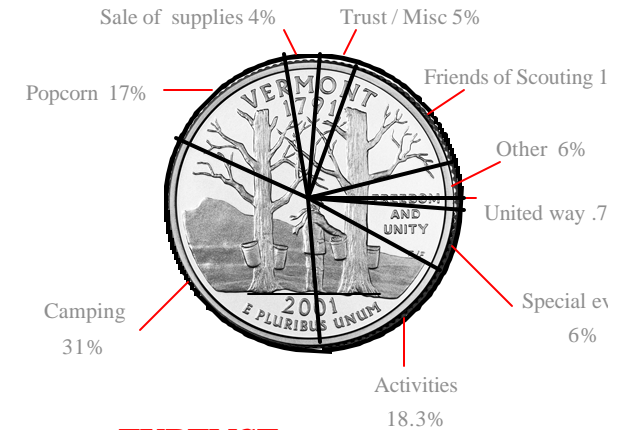
OUTDOORS
