## “Le Great Voyageur Expedition”

Sept 16-18, 2016

### *Activities to include;*

**"Canoe Drag Racing"** – Plow through the rough waves and try to stay in the boat. This is going to be fast, so hold on!

**"The Great Portage"** – You and your crew must maneuver a canoe and all the gear up, down and around the obstacle course.

**"Canadian Frog Hop"** – speed, distance and coordination required. So bring your best set of frog legs.

**"Paddle Toss"** – sometimes a Voyageur only had a paddle to take down a moose. Test your skills in throwing a paddle for distance and accuracy.

**"Perch Pitch"** – no live animals will be injured during this activity. It will be taken care a week in advance. (prepare to get slimy, no fish will go unturned!)

**"Tabbacadah Spat"** – with luck and a good tail wind you should be able to go the distance. (no tobacco used, we have an alternate). Wet beards may be washed Monday morning before going to work.....or not.

**"Firewood Jenga"** – You know the rules, now the game is full sized!

**"The Voyageur's Coffee Pot"** - The Captain must have his cup of coffee, and he wants it NOW! Test your skills to think on the run. This will be the premier afternoon event.

**"BACONATOR"**- There will be a Dutch oven contest. You will need to bring your own Dutch oven. You must use 1 pound of bacon in your recipe. Other ingredients related to the theme are potatoes, corn, beans, peas, carrots, cheese, bear fat, dried fruit, pre-pitched perch, etc...

We will not have the Battle of the Bands this year. Your unit should prepare a skit (3-5 minutes) It must have relevance to the theme; Canadian Voyageurs, canoeing, camping, eating bear fat, paddling the white waters, etc...

**"Scoutmaster Award"** - Like always, we have some SA-WEEEEET prizes and a special treat for the Scoutmaster with the best crew. Scoutmasters will be judged on Troop participation and placement in competitions. He/she will receive some well-earned refreshment for keeping the crew motivated.

**"Bog Beaver Day"** - This is a day where we clean up our campsites and activity areas. The date is set for 09/11/2016, however you can take your unit up any day after 09/03/2016 to clean up your site. A Scout is Helpful, if you see work that needs to be done, like a fallen tree or another site that needs attention, feel free to fulfill your Good Turn Daily requirement.

**"Saturday Night Special"** – After handing out some sa-weeet awards, we will have a very unique ceremony. This is something that everyone will remember! If you're not there, you're probably somewhere else.

**"Class A Uniform"** – Must be worn at the Saturday morning opening ceremonies, Saturday evening awards ceremony and Sunday morning service. During the activities you will want to wear something to identify your Voyageur Crew.
