All Units need to bring with them:

- ✦ A GPS (There will be limited quantities available on site if your unit does not have one let us know ahead of time, please.)
- ✦ Each Unit will build some kind of safety/distress signal or gadget at their site, so use your imagination!
- ✦ Each Scout should bring a compass with them.
- ✦ Units will be responsible for their own meals for the weekend so make sure you plan a great menu ahead of time.

All Patrols need to bring with them:

- ✦ Each Patrol will also need to bring with them a fully equipped Bug-Out-Bag designed for one person for three days of survival and the patrol will need to keep it with them throughout the day's events. Get creative and pack this before you come to the camporee!

At the end of the day on Saturday we will have an awards ceremony and closing.

Camporee Wide Dessert Cook-Off

A tradition at many camporees is a cook-off and these year we will be doing a dessert cook-off. It is a great way to encourage fellowship between troops and packs. Each unit will need to prepare a dessert to share with the judges and other attendees. The dessert should be enough to feed the entire unit, judges and a few extras, but you are encouraged to bring more. The more people that get to score your dessert the more points you will get!

Each Scout will get a ticket and a chance to vote for their favorite dessert. No voting for your own unit.

Each unit will need to supply a dessert, a server and utensils to serve with and each Scout should have their own mess kit.

All entries must be prepared on site and be sure to swap out your servers so they get a chance to vote as well.

This will be a tasting event so; the servers need to only give each Scout a taste of their dessert. All the tastes should add up to a full dessert with all the different desserts. If you have Scouts in your unit that have special nutritional or dietary needs, you should take that into consideration for both safety and back up dessert.

This will take place under the tent.
