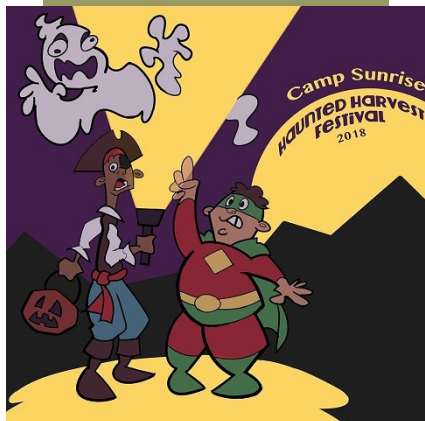

20th Annual Haunted Harvest Festival

The 20th Annual *Cub Scout Haunted Harvest Fest* will take place on Saturday, October 20th, 2018 at Camp Sunrise in Benson, Vermont. Registration starts at 9:00 am and ends at 10:00 am. Opening ceremony begins at 10:15 am. Activities begin at 10:30 am and end at 3:00 pm followed by the closing campfire at 3:30 pm. This is the premier Cub Scout family activity of the Fall where hundreds of Cub Scouts and families attend the *spooky event* each year, rain or shine. This is a

great way for Cub Scouts and parents to experience Camp Sunrise for the first time. **Early bird registration is \$12.00 plus a can of soup per person.** (No cream soup) The family fee max is \$40.00. Hot dog, chips, soup and beverage provided. **Improved check in process makes it easier on leaders! Just register as a pack and arrive at camp. On arrival all participants will go to a registration area for wristbands, maps and a schedule of events.**

Registration and roster forms **must** be received with **full** payment by October 10th, 2018

Starting October 11th, 2018 the fee is \$17.00 and \$45.00 per family..

The final date for registrations is October 16th, 2018.

Registrations are entered on a first come-first-served basis. Register as a pack.

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INSTRUCTIONS FOR LEADERS



1. Don't wait until the next Committee meeting or Pack meeting to discuss this event. Call or visit the parents of the boys in the pack or den and encourage their attendance. It is fun for the whole family.
2. Contact the boys and families immediately. Most dens meet weekly and typically den leaders will see parents before or after the den meeting. If not, a few phone calls from the Den Leader to the parents will guarantee the boys get the chance to participate in this fun filled day.
3. Be forthcoming about the paid-in-full registration deadline! Everyone responds to expectations, and parents

and leaders certainly understand that an event of this size requires deadlines to be successful.

4. Create your own Pack paid-in-full deadline so the Pack can make the October 10th, 2018 deadline. Registration is limited due to the program areas, staffing and dining hall capacity. A reminder that the fee goes up by \$5.00 for all registrations received starting October 11th, 2018.

5. Don't say no for the Cub Scouts. They love this event as do leaders and parents. Pack participation in a "big event" like this adds so much to the Pack program, and statistics have shown that parents are more likely to join the committee or "help out when asked" after they've been to Camp Sunrise for an event.

6. Anticipate payment difficulties. Perhaps the Pack treasury can assist families who may have difficulty making your deadline. Make sure all leaders have accurate information about this subject before they begin contacting families.
7. One Pack check payable to the Green Mountain Council is preferred. VISA, MasterCard and Discover accepted. **Beat the deadline—Register Early!**
8. Upon Arrival at Camp everyone will park and then head to registration where soup will be dropped off and participants will pick up their wristbands and maps. Participants will be able to check in individually based on the pack submitted roster.
