Parade Vehicle Criteria

NO HAZARDOUS MATERIALS NO CYLINDERS OF ANY TYPE NO GAS OR FUEL CONTAINERS

NO GASOLINE POWERED GENERATORS

For Drivers:

- 1. ALL drivers must have in possession a valid driver's license.
- 2. **ALL** drivers **must have in possession** registration for the vehicle they operate.
- 3. ALL CDL DRIVERS MUST HAVE A CURRENT MEDICAL CARD IN POSSESSION.
- 4. The **DRIVER** is responsible for the actions of persons on vehicles and floats.

For Vehicles:

- 1. ALL CDL vehicles must be in compliance with FMCSA (Federal Motor Carrier Safety Act).
- 2. ALL vehicles, trailers and floats must be registered.
- 3. ALL vehicles must have a valid state inspection.
- 4. ALL vehicles including floats must have working brake lights & turn signals.
- 5. ALL vehicles must have functioning brakes, including air brakes.
- 6. ALL floats & trailers must use safety chains.
- 7. ALL props on floats & trailers must be secured or tied down to prevent movement.
- 8. NO THROWING OF CANDY, BEADS OR ANY OTHER MATERIAL FROM ANY VEHICLE.
- 9. **ALL** floats & trailers **must** provide adequate safety measures for all riders to prevent falling. Hand holds for each rider.

NO GOING OFF AND ON TRUCKS or FLOATS.

- 10. NO oversize floats or vehicles. Maximum width of 102". Maximum length of trailer is not to exceed 53'. Only single trailer/float units.
- 11. NO vehicles with defective tires.
- 12. **NO** vehicles with suspension defects.
- 13. NO vehicles with visible fuel leaks.
- 14. NO overweight, overloaded, or over height vehicles.
- 15. NO alcohol on vehicles or floats.
- 16. Any staging on trailer bed must conform to State & Federal Safety Regulations.
- 17. **LIVESTOCK**: It is expected that you will clean up after your animals before, during and along the parade route so plan accordingly please and thank you.
