- Outdoor Equipment and Outdoor Ethics
- Cub Scout cooking
- Cub Scouts and GPS, Aquatics, Knife Safety
- First Aid and sanitation
- Stoves, Lanterns and Camping Equipment
- Safety

And with the new curriculum:

- Camping overnight (bring your own individual sized tent, sleeping bag, etc)

BALOO is an all day course with a camping overnight. Parts of the training will be held outdoors so please dress appropriately. Please also bring your completed BSA Medical form – only Parts A&B are required. Please see the information on the Green Mountain Council website for more details.
