Merit Badge and Campout

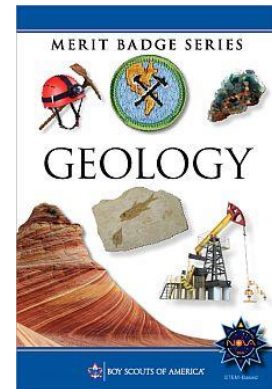


in Barre at the

Come for a weekend of dirty fun while participating in a geological survey of the Stevens Branch of the Winooski River in Barre. Learn how to be a geologist while getting your merit badge. Also learn about the geological history of Vermont from Dr. Scott A. McLaughlin, Director of the Vermont Granite Museum, and other professional geologists.

Participants are encouraged to camp for the weekend onsite at the Vermont Granite Museum. Troop contingents or individual Scouts are welcome. All meals are provided.

- Scouts will discuss how geologists learn about rock formations.
- Scouts will learn about resources that can be extracted or mined for commercial use.
- Scouts will review a geologic map of Vermont and discuss the different rock types and estimated ages of rocks represented.
- Scouts will find out about career opportunities available in geology.
- Scouts will learn about sedimentary process by studying the Stevens Branch of the Winooski River.
