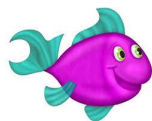

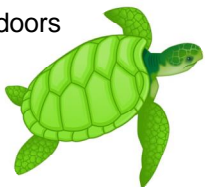
What will Scouts do?

Cubs will be grouped into dens by rank with a volunteer Camp Den Leader, and will rotate through various program areas and Under the Sea activities throughout the day. Activities will include:

What should Scouts bring?

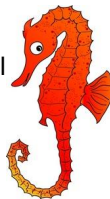
- ~ Light backpack
- ~ Sunscreen (apply before arriving at camp)
- ~ Refillable water bottle
- ~ Rain gear (activities will continue outdoors during light rain)
- ~ Hat (sun protection)
- ~ Closed-toe shoes
- ~ Good attitude!
- ~ A friend! Sign up a buddy to join the fun!



Transportation to and from the Day Camp site is the responsibility of the parents. Car pools are encouraged and are part of the fun. (Car pool drivers are invited to join the fun and be on staff for the day!)

Camp uniform (for Scouts and Staff) is the camp T-shirt. One shirt is included in the cost for every camper; full-week volunteers will be issued two free shirts. Additional shirts may be purchased. These shirts will be given out upon arrival on Monday and must be worn every day of camp. Comfortable shoes are a must. NO open-toed shoes, flip-flops, or sandals. Be prepared: this is a rain or shine event.

Food: Lunch is scheduled around noon each day, will last approximately 30 minutes, and then be followed by some type of quiet-time activity. Breakfast and lunch are being provided to those under age 18 by the Hunger Free Vermont summer meals program. Menus will be provided in advance of camp, so that you may send food with your child on those days when the offering does not meet your child's needs. **Please send your child with a refillable water bottle.**

Visitors are discouraged during Day Camp. We do love to have you volunteer and spend a day or more with us, but we have found that drop-in visits are a distraction to both Cub Scouts and activity volunteers. Please give your child space to fully embrace the day.

Health Forms: All Camp participants (youth and adults) MUST submit a current BSA medical form (Parts A and B). **PLEASE MAIL THE COMPLETED MEDICAL FORM WITH THIS REGISTRATION** (*don't forget to attach a copy of your health insurance card*). If there are compelling reasons this is not possible, the completed medical form must be turned in upon arrival at camp Monday morning. Scouts will not be allowed to remain in camp without this form. A Camp Health Officer will be on hand for first aid (not medical treatment) and to oversee the administration of any medications needed during Day Camp hours.
