NYLT PERSONAL EQUIPMENT CHECKLIST

At NYLT, we always wear the NYLT field uniform or the NYLT activity uniform. The field uniform consists of an official short-sleeved uniform shirt with insignia correctly placed, your units neck wear, official uniform pants/shorts, official belt, and official socks. The activity uniform is the same, except that a NYLT course t-shirt is worn instead of the short sleeve shirt and neckerchief. **Two NYLT course t-shirts and one NYLT hat will be provided at registration.** The field and activity uniforms will be worn throughout the week. Everyone must be in his or her official field uniform upon arrival to camp (see first 4 items on the required list). All badges and insignia must be properly placed on the field uniform.

Be prepared for an overnight hike/outpost as well as living in camp. At least one pair of shoes must be suitable for hiking. Place your name on all clothing and personal items. Any items that you do not own, please borrow. **A hiking backpack is required for getting all your gear from the parking lot to the campsite and for the Outpost. Participants must not use suitcases, footlockers, trunks, duffle bags, or Rubbermaid containers.**

<input type="checkbox"/>	Official Field Uniform pants or shorts (2 suggested)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Official Uniform socks (3 pair minimum)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Official belt or leather Scout belt and buckle
<input type="checkbox"/>	NYLT Official Scout t-shirt (provided at check-in)
<input type="checkbox"/>	NYLT Official cap (provided at check-in)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Extra Scout t-shirts (2 minimum)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Hiking boots or "sturdy" athletic shoes. No clogs, crocs, "jellies" flip flops, fashion sandals and/or open-toe or open-heel shoes.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Pajamas/Sleepwear
<input type="checkbox"/>	Rain poncho or rain jacket and rain pants – It will rain at some point!
<input type="checkbox"/>	Sweater, Jacket, and/or Sweatshirt
<input type="checkbox"/>	Water shoes for the shower
<input type="checkbox"/>	Swimming suit (full coverage/suitable for sports) and beach towel
<input type="checkbox"/>	Shirts and shorts for each day. Shirts for daily wear need to cover shoulders for sun protection. A quick-drying t-shirt for water activities is highly recommended. Please no halter or open midriff tops.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Underwear for each day
<input type="checkbox"/>	Socks for each day plus extra pairs
<input type="checkbox"/>	Long pants (2 pair minimum)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Sleeping bag and pillow
<input type="checkbox"/>	1 liter canteen or water bottle (essential to camp!)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Personal eating utensils, plate, cup and bowl
<input type="checkbox"/>	Headlamp or flashlight w/ extra batteries
<input type="checkbox"/>	Toothbrush, toothpaste, and floss
<input type="checkbox"/>	Hand soap, body wash, shampoo, deodorant
<input type="checkbox"/>	Towel & washcloth / Comb or brush
<input type="checkbox"/>	Sun screen (no aerosol cans permitted) and lip balm
<input type="checkbox"/>	Insect repellent (no aerosol cans permitted)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Laundry bag and clothespins
<input type="checkbox"/>	Watch (highly recommended, but not absolutely necessary)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Work gloves and work pants
<input type="checkbox"/>	Small day pack to carry binder, raingear, ...

<input type="checkbox"/>	Prescribed medication (*see NOTE below)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Pen, pencil, and small notebook
<input type="checkbox"/>	Camp chair (highly recommended, but not necessary)

OPTIONAL ITEMS	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Sunglasses and extra glasses or contact lenses in case yours are lost or broken
<input type="checkbox"/>	Camera - no cell phone cameras allowed. Camp is not responsible for any damaged or lost cameras.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Mosquito netting to hang above your bunk
<input type="checkbox"/>	Alarm clock
<input type="checkbox"/>	Money for World Friendship Fund & Trading Post
⊗ PROHIBITED ITEMS ⊗	
If these items are brought to camp, they may be confiscated and returned to the parents/guardians at the end of the camp session.	
⊗	Cell Phones
⊗	Fireworks, firearms or weapons including pocket knives
⊗	Electronics – iPods, MP3 players, etc...
⊗	Any food items including drinks
⊗	Lighter, matches, and any flammable liquids
⊗	Any clothing with inappropriate or offensive images/text.

Please bring everything on this list, and nothing that is not on this list!

* **NOTE:** All medications must be in their original pharmacy/manufacturer's bottles with dosages clearly indicated. All prescription medications must be turned in to the course medical officer at check-in. Participants must keep track of their own needs and see the medical officer whenever they need medications.
