Paperwork Checklist

Everyone!

- Campers and all staff need to provide completed BSA Medical Form, Parts A&B.
- As of right now, we all must fill out a Covid-19 Pre-Event Screening Checklist EACH DAY of camp. Camper and youth staff checklists must be signed by their parents EVERY day.

Parents

- New Scout Registration Form for campers registering with Scouts BSA for the first time. Please fill out the form and bring it to camp Monday morning.
